

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION MEETING FOR THE PROPOSED ABLES SPRINGS 138 kV TRANSMISSION LINE PROJECT

Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor) is proposing to construct two new 138 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission lines in Kaufman County. Combined, the proposed transmission lines will be a total of approximately 10-18 miles long, depending upon the routes certificated by the Public Utility Commission of Texas. The first new transmission line will connect the proposed North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD) Water Treatment Plant located along CR 329 at CR 330 to the existing Oncor Duck Cove Substation located along FM 429 at CR 336 in northeastern Kaufman County. The second line will begin at the proposed NTMWD Water Treatment Plant and terminate at a point of intersection with the existing Oncor Royse-Terrell Switch 138 kV Transmission Line, located in the western portion of the Study Area.

Oncor is committed to routing the proposed transmission lines in a manner consistent with the values of the local communities, the Texas Utilities Code, the Public Utility Commission of Texas Rules and Policies, and the need to provide reliable electric service to this area of North Texas. In support of the routing process, Oncor is holding a public participation meeting, to be held at the Terrell ISD

Performing Arts Center that is located at 400 Poetry Road, Terrell, Texas, to solicit input for use in determining routing for the proposed transmission lines and share information about line routing alternatives. LOPEZGARCIA GROUP, a consulting firm retained by Oncor for the project, has identified preliminary alternative transmission line routes for consideration which are shown as dashed lines on the map below. In addition, maps with greater detail will be exhibited at the meeting. Individuals attending the "come and go" open house meeting will have an opportunity to ask questions and provide information to representatives and technical experts from Oncor and LOPEZGARCIA GROUP, regarding the routing of the proposed transmission lines. These preliminary alternative routes are subject to modification based on further study and information received at the public meeting.
