

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION MEETING FOR THE PROPOSED BELL COUNTY EAST – TNP ONE 345 KV TRANSMISSION LINE

Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor) is proposing to construct a new 345 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line in Bell, Falls, Milam and Robertson Counties. The proposed transmission line will be approximately 40 miles long, depending upon the route certificated by the Public Utility Commission of Texas. The proposed transmission line will connect the proposed Bell County East Switching Station (located southeast of Temple, Texas on Shaw Road in Bell County) to the existing TNP One Switching Station (located south of Bremond, Texas on Highway 6 in Robertson County).

Oncor is committed to routing the proposed transmission line in a manner consistent with the values of the local communities, the Texas Utilities Code, the Public Utility Commission of Texas Rules and Policies, and the need to provide reliable electric service to this area of Central Texas. In support of the routing process, Oncor is holding a public participation meeting to solicit input for use in determining the preferred route for the proposed transmission line and share information about line routing alternatives. POWER Engineers (POWER), a consulting firm retained by Oncor for the project, has identified preliminary alternative transmission line routes for consideration which are shown as dashed lines on the map below. POWER will be available at the meeting to discuss these routes. Maps with greater detail will be exhibited at the meeting. Individuals attending this “come and go” open house meeting will have an opportunity to ask questions of and provide information to representatives and technical experts from Oncor and POWER regarding the routing of the proposed transmission line. These preliminary alternative routes are subject to modification based on further study and information received at the public meeting.
