Oncor Electric Delivery Company (Oncor) is proposing to rebuild the existing 345 kilovolt (kV) overhead electric transmission line from Oncor's existing Bowman Switching Station located south of Farm to Market Road (FM) 1954 and east of Seel Road in Archer County, Texas, to the existing Jacksboro Switching Station located northwest of State Highway 59 in Jack County, Texas. The existing 345 kV single-circuit line is approximately 46 miles long and will be rebuilt and upgraded to a double-circuit 345 kV line along the existing centerline and within the existing right-of-way. The location of the existing transmission line to be rebuilt is shown as a dashed line on the map. Maps with greater detail will be exhibited at the meeting.

Oncor is committed to rebuilding the existing transmission line in a manner consistent with the values of the local communities, the Texas Utilities Code, the Public Utility Commission of Texas Rules and Policies, and the need to provide reliable electric service to this area of Texas. Oncor would like to share information with the local community regarding this project at an Open House Meeting to be held in the community. In order to accomplish this, Oncor wants to give individuals attending this "come and go" Open House Meeting the opportunity to ask questions of representatives and technical experts from Oncor regarding the proposed transmission line project.
