Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor) is proposing to construct a new 345 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line in Angelina County, Texas. The proposed transmission line will connect the existing Oncor Herty North Switching Station (located on Davisville Road, northeast of Lufkin) to the existing Oncor Lufkin Switching Station (located north of Craft Fenley Loop, west of Lufkin). The proposed transmission line will be approximately eight miles long, depending upon the route certificated by the Public Utility Commission of Texas.

Oncor is committed to routing the proposed transmission line in a manner consistent with the values of the local communities, the Texas Utilities Code, the Public Utility Commission of Texas Rules and Policies, and the need to provide reliable electric service to this area of Texas. In order to accomplish this, Oncor wants to solicit input for use in determining the preferred route for the proposed transmission line and share information about line routing alternatives. Burns & McDonnell, a consulting firm retained by Oncor for the project, has identified preliminary alternative transmission line routes for consideration. These preliminary alternative routes are shown as dashed lines on the map below. Maps with greater detail will be exhibited at the meeting. Individuals attending this “come and go” open house meeting will have an opportunity to ask questions and make comments to representatives and technical experts from Oncor and Burns & McDonnell regarding the routing of the proposed transmission line. These preliminary alternative routes are subject to modification based on further study and the results of this public meeting.
