Oncor Electric Delivery Company (Oncor) is proposing to rebuild the existing 345 kilovolt (kV) overhead electric transmission line from Oncor’s existing Jacksboro Switching Station located northwest of State Highway 59 in Jack County, Texas to the existing Parker Switching Station located south of Pearson Ranch Road near the intersection of Farm to Market Road (FM) 730 in Parker County. The existing 345 kV single-circuit line is approximately 40 miles long and will be rebuilt and upgraded to a double-circuit 345 kV line along the existing centerline and within the existing right-of-way. The location of the existing transmission line to be rebuilt is shown as a dashed line on the map. Maps with greater detail will be exhibited at the meeting.

Oncor is committed to rebuilding the existing transmission line in a manner consistent with the values of the local communities, the Texas Utilities Code, the Public Utility Commission of Texas Rules and Policies, and the need to provide reliable electric service to this area of Texas. Oncor would like to share information with the local community regarding this project at two Open House Meetings to be held in the community. In order to accomplish this, Oncor wants to give individuals attending these “come and go” Open House Meetings the opportunity to ask questions of representatives and technical experts from Oncor regarding the proposed transmission line project.
