- [2-4 Oncor volunteers to help with set up and tear down]

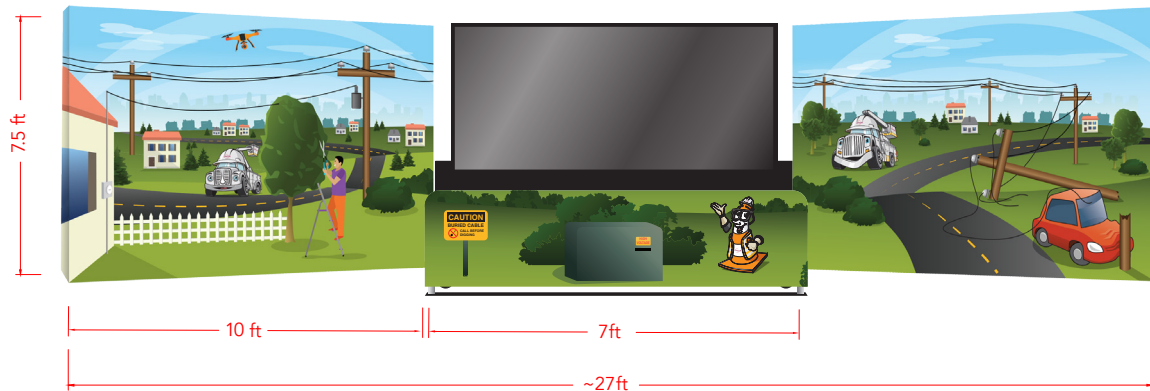


EXHIBIT DETAILS

- Exhibit requires access to at least three 20 amps breaker outlets.
- Events are held indoor.
 - Indoor footprint in gym is 30'x20'.
 - Access to at least a 38" door width is needed, double doors without a center pole are ideal.
 - Access to ramps (handicap ramps) is highly recommended for bringing materials into a facility.
- Our materials are housed in a 24-foot trailer. We will need to park as close to the event location as possible to unpack. Curbside access for indoor events is recommended.
- Set up and tear down requires 1 hour each. It's best to load and unload before and after school bus loading and unloading times.
